FIELD OF PLAY	<p>The Field of Play (FOP) is the competition area. No spectators are permitted in this area. Only athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers for the event are permitted into the area. Volunteers are in this area only for the event they volunteered for.</p> <p>The FOP varies by facility and may vary by event. Watch for signs at the pool and let your members attending the competitions know about the FOP area.</p>

ELIGIBILITY

Competitive athletes must be registered with Saskatchewan Artistic Swimming

Competition: 10U, 12U, Novice, Youth, Junior, and AdAS.

Coaches: all coaches must have proper certification to receive accreditation for deck access at the competition.

For the 2024-2025 season, SAS is running a pilot project where Limited Competitive athletes will have the option to compete at Marnie's Meet in addition to Sadie Caulder Knight.

EVENTS

This event is a combined figure competition on November 23, 2024, and camp day on November 24, 2024.

Figures: All age groups.

HP Summer Provincial Team Trials: As per the 2024-2025 HP Working Booklet, athletes intending to participate in these trials must register for the Junior figure event at this competition.

- Junior athletes - register as usual.
- Youth and 12U - register as usual in Youth and 12U figures. Also register these athletes in Junior figures. They will compete as Exhibition in the Junior event. Please notify the SAS TD of all Exhibition athletes.

HP Trials Notes:

- Only athletes participating in these HP trials are permitted to register in two figure events.
- Athletes required to register in two figure events only pay the fee for one figure event.
- Athletes competing in two different age groups may compete in back-to-back events.

REGISTRATION

We are currently investigating the registration process using CAS's RAMP online competition registration system and expect to finalize the registration process for Marnie's Meet on or before October 10, 2024. Stay tuned for another email with the details of this registration process.

LATE ENTRIES

The club will be charged a **fine of \$25.00** for each late entry and a fine of \$200.00 will be charged for each late "club" entry.

It is the club /coach and/or swimmer's responsibility to pay this fine to the Chief Referee no later than hour prior to the beginning of the competition. Failure to do so shall result in disqualification.

REGISTRATION FEES

Saskatchewan Artistic Swimming must receive entry fees **two weeks** prior to the competition.

REFUND POLICY

There are NO refunds after the registration deadline unless a written request or medical certificate is submitted to the Executive Director. The request may be submitted any time prior to the event the athlete is competing in. Note: Documents must be submitted as soon as possible.

ADMISSIONS

Spectators for the artistic swimming figure events will require a wristband to access the designated seating area. There will be an admission fee of \$5 for anyone 10 and older. Children under 10 are free.

ACCREDITATIONS AND LANYARDS

All officials, coaches and volunteers must wear lanyards on deck to access the FOP. Accreditations for the new season are distributed as follows:

- Officials – Head Judge will distribute during the Officials Meeting.
- Coaches – SAS Technical Director will distribute during the Coaches Meeting.
- Volunteers – pick up accreditations at the volunteer check-in table.

FIGURES

Complete figure list for this competition is listed at the end of this document labeled Appendix A – Figure List at the end of the document.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers are key to running a successful competition. SAS determines the number of volunteers required. Clubs attending the competition will be asked to provide volunteers.

VOLUNTEER TRAINING

SAS will provide a volunteer training session or online webinar before this competition. **If you are a volunteer for any competition this season, you are strongly encouraged to attend.**

Date and time for this training will be provided closer to date of competition.

SIGNAGE

All signage in areas of the facility booked for the competition must be approved by Saskatchewan Artistic Swimming, including any signage the Host Club would like to set up. Saskatchewan Artistic Swimming will determine the location where signage may be displayed. Signage will not be permitted to impact upon the competition.

All clubs have equal opportunity to post signage at the competition. Requests from clubs must be submitted by October 26, 2024, to SAS Events and Communications Director. Request must include an image and dimensions of the signage and where the signage will be placed at the facility.

SCHEDULE

Tentative schedule:

- Saturday 8 am - 5 pm - Figures
- Saturday 6 pm - 9 pm - Banquet
- Sunday 7:30 am - 1 pm - Athlete Camp

Final Schedule will be published separately.

AWARDS

Ribbons for 1-6 place in all events.

Awards recognize our athlete's achievements. The awards ceremony is a time of celebration. All awards will be presented at the banquet on Saturday evening.

RESULTS

Results will be posted by the Chief Scorer during the competition on the Sportity App and posted on the Saskatchewan Artistic Swimming website www.saskartisticswimming.ca after the competition.

PHOTOGRAPHY

All athletes, coaches, volunteers, and officials may be filmed or photographed during the competition. The videos and photos may be used without permission or authorization of individuals, parents, or clubs. We encourage clubs to send their photos to ECD@saskartisticswimming.ca for posting on Facebook or Instagram.

FACILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ATHLETES, COACHES, OFFICIALS, VOLUNTEERS AND SPECTATORS

To ensure that artistic swimmers continue to uphold a high standard of conduct, and that we are always welcomed at pool and hotel facilities, we respectfully ask that coaches discuss the following rules with their athletes and club members (parents, club volunteers, etc.) and request these rules are followed:

- All street shoes **MUST** be removed when on the deck area, if required by facility.
- All food and drink must be consumed in the designated eating areas at the pool facility.
- Everyone attending the event, including athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, and spectators are to behave in a mature manner, respecting the guidelines set out by the facility. Any individual not respecting the guidelines may be asked to leave the facility.
- All facilities are to be left in the way they were found at the beginning of the day.

RELIGIOUS OR MEDICAL ADORNMENTS

Any club with an athlete who will wear a religious or medical alert adornment while competing must send a note by registration deadline to SAS Technical Director at TD@saskartisticswimming.ca

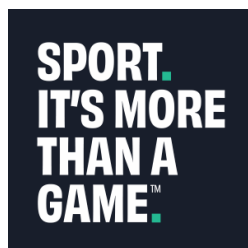
ACCOMODATIONS
